We supported a COVID snack delivery mission that rose up from the congregation! In a time that felt desperate, God helped us make a new way to connect, worship, learn, and serve together, and we’re not done yet! Watch for our creative, new Online Stewardship platform coming soon as well as the possibility of a virtual congregational meeting!
